Shakedown Run by James Harris

In 2018, after 4 years of restoration from a basket case, I felt that my '69 TR6 was reliable enough for a longer trip. I made a plan to visit some destinations as part of the 2018 Moss Motoring Challenge. I embarked on the two-day round-trip to the southeastern tip of California at the Plank Road monument, in the Algodones Dunes just off interstate I-8 (old US 80). Along the way I stopped at the El Mirage Dry Lake, touched on highway US 66 and visited the Hwy 66 Museum in Victorville, visited the Santa Fe rail depot (1918) in San Bernardino (had a really long chat with one of the docents there), the Palm Springs Air Museum (several long chats with the docents there) and rounded the Salton Sea at some 150 ft below sea-level before spending the night in El Centro. The only problems that had cropped up with the TR were an intermittently wonky RH turn signal that caused my ammeter to jump erratically and oil consumption - I had to add a qt at 234 miles and another at 463 miles.

On day 2, I was on the road again before dawn to go visit the Plank Road monument, marking a point along some 17 miles of wooden highway over the dunes that was built in 1915 and lasted in service for the next 11 years. After paying my respects to this marvel I headed towards the Borrego Springs Sculpture Garden for some amazing desert artwork and landscapes. Then up county road S-22, a spectacular, twisting two-lane road that climbs 3,500 ft in 12 miles. The weather went from 100-degree sunshine to 50 degrees in the fog and rain over the span of 50 miles.

After finding my way past the Mount Palomar Observatory and down to old highway US 395 I headed up towards Moreno Valley and the March AFB Air Museum. My dad had been stationed there in 1940 before being shipped out to the Pacific war and had one of the first squadrons of B-17Bs and Y1B17s there. I enjoyed revisiting that historic airfield and also thought of the long-lost Riverside International Raceway, where I spent much time in my youth, that was right next door.

As the sun was setting, I turned for home and made the last 90-mile stint up the clogged freeways through the Cajon Pass and the otherworldly landscape of Joshua trees and dry lakes towards home. I totaled 738 miles over the two days and all the while my TR6 was the best of all things, reliable!

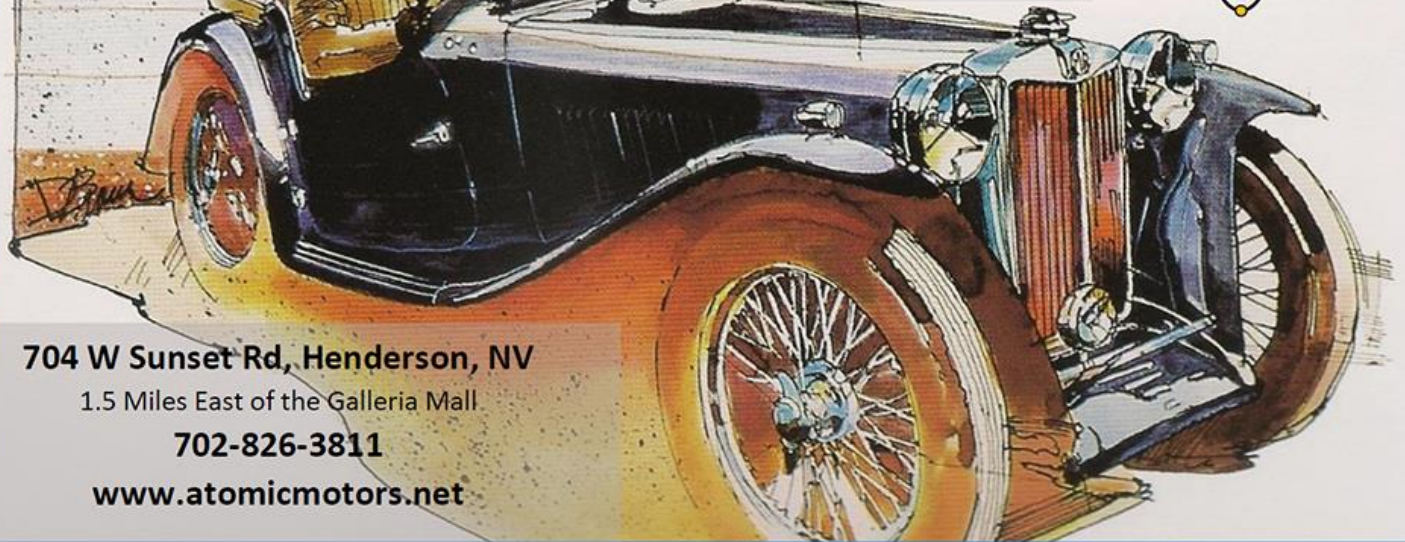
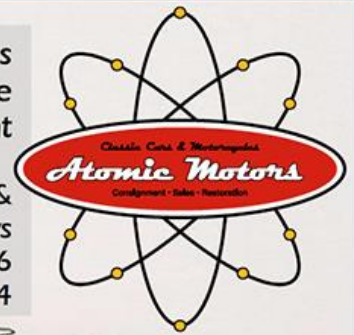

A 1995 refurbishment consisted of a bare metal repaint in white, adding a steel dashboard and a Borg Warner 5-speed manual gearbox, and a conversion to left-hand drive by Maidstone Sports Cars in the United Kingdom. Power comes from a 3.5-Liter Rover V8, and additional modifications include a Quaife limited-slip differential, SS headers, and a tuned exhaust system. Shortly after the seller's acquisition in 2015, Huffaker Engineering in Sonoma, California performed an interior refresh and an engine/gearbox service, as well as installing new suspension bushings, an aluminum radiator, a FAB-TEK suspension, and more as detailed in the listing. 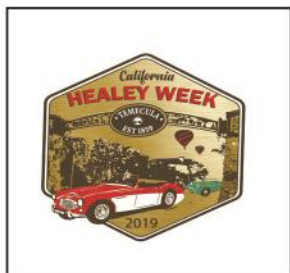
