A Triumph TR3A Story by Joel Justin

# **COVER STORY**



This 1960 TR3A has been a Southern California all its life and a Camarillo car for most of it. For all intents and purposes, this is a one owner car, but technically, it's a three owner car. It was purchased new by a father who bought a Pale Yellow TR3A for one daughter and this Powder Blue one for the other. She owned/drove it for about 40 years before it was parked (unfortunately without proper fluid prep) sometime before she passed away in October 2001. Her husband survived her but didn't drive the car. Rather it sat covered in their garage. He passed in September 2013 and their son and daughter (who was a legally blind distance runner on the US Olympic Team in 2000 and 2004) put it up for sale shortly after that.

Ray DeSilva (who's a CCBCC member) happened to see it at a house in Camarillo less than a mile from where he lives. It was in an open garage under a cover. He knocked on the door and found it was for sale. He bought it with the plans of rebuilding it and upping the performance at the same time. But in the meantime, he found an Austin Healey 3000 Mk2 that was ready to drive and bought it, putting the TR3 project to the side. He only had it for only a short time before he decided to sell it.

I saw it for sale in Hemming's and with it being in Camarillo, I couldn't pass up at least a look. You can guess how that "look" went. Boy was it clean! The paint and interior were in great shape. There were absolutely no signs of rust underneath, where it was very clean too. Most of the chrome was pitted and dull, but other than that, it was a fantastic base to start from.

During its time in unprepped storage, several things happened to it. First, the head gasket failed and coolant leaked into the #3 and #4 cylinders, seizing the engine. Second, the master brake and clutch cylinders started leaking creating a waterfall of brake fluid and bubbled paint underneath it. Finally, the 4-5 gallons of fuel in the gas tank smelled unlike anything I've smelled before.

Knowing the TR engine has wet liner cylinders, the seized engine would be an easy fix. And of course the brake and fuel systems would need a complete overhaul as well, neither of which are difficult. So I bought the car in January 2015. Having lots of Triumph projects in the hopper and garage space to store it, the TR3A sat until June 2018. That's when I bought another Triumph (my 2000 Saloon) and needed to get the TR3A finished to sell as I was now out of garage space!

I tore the engine apart and took it to the machine shop. As best as I could tell it had never been apart before. My goal was to keep as many of the original parts as possible, so other that new pistons and liners (87mm instead of the original 83's), the oil pump and water pump, everything was original. I rebuilt the carburetors and fuel pump as well.

I put in all new brake and clutch hydraulics and lines as the old system was completely shot. I also drained that nasty fuel out of the fuel tank and reconditioned it as well as cleaning out the fuel line. New brakes were installed on all four corners and the cooling system was flushed with new hoses added. I had to replace the heater as the original was too far gone. I also restored all the gauges and dashboard. All the chrome was polished except for a couple of pieces that were replaced. The interior vinyl and carpets were cleaned and amazingly, I believe original to the car.

It had one repaint in the original color, probably in the 80's or 90's, but it still looks very good with no dings or dents anywhere and only a few chips. I stripped and repainted the brake fluid waterfall area under the bonnet and replace the steering bushes and tie rod ends. About the only things I didn't do was rebuild the suspension and replace the top, tonneau and hoodstick cover, and have the side curtains rebuilt. They're all there and I believe the original ones that shipped with the car in 1960. One other thing about this car that's unique is that it has the original (complete) tool kit, jack and engine cranking handle. It also has the original bias-ply spare tire and its original CA black license plate. (Continued on next page)

I've only driven it about 250 miles since the rebuild, but it starts right up and drives well, the gearbox shifting crisply. And what else is amazing is that all the gauges and lights work. I had to change a couple of burned out bulbs, but other than that, they all work. I did install a headlight relay kit as I was nervous about

all that current doing thru the almost 60 year old light switch!

I'll be putting this car up for sale shortly – after I get another 100 miles or so on it, so if you're interested in a very original TR3A with a neat story behind it, let me know.






