When we think LBC (Little British Car), high performance speed records are not the first thing that comes to mind. More like, will it start or what electrical gremlin will I be addressing today?

Recently, MG revealed its Electric Hyper-car concept inspired by the Legendary EX 181 Streamliner. What's that you say? Well, the EX 181 Streamliner was a land speed record breaker, driven by the legendary Phil Hill up to 254.9 MPH in 1959. It set the world 2000cc Class E record and remains the fastest MG ever made.



It doesn't look much like an MG and neither does its electric hybrid replacement, code named EXE 181. Not a very original name but it certainly looks different. The new version is expected to reach 257.87 MPH. You may say, big deal, 3 more mph! But in the speed record world, that is a massive difference.



A membership list will be put together in the near future and passed out to the membership so I would like you to send me or give me at the next meeting the enclosed questionaire.


