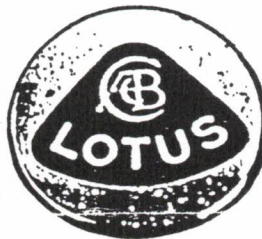

Peoples choice, best Marque awards given.)

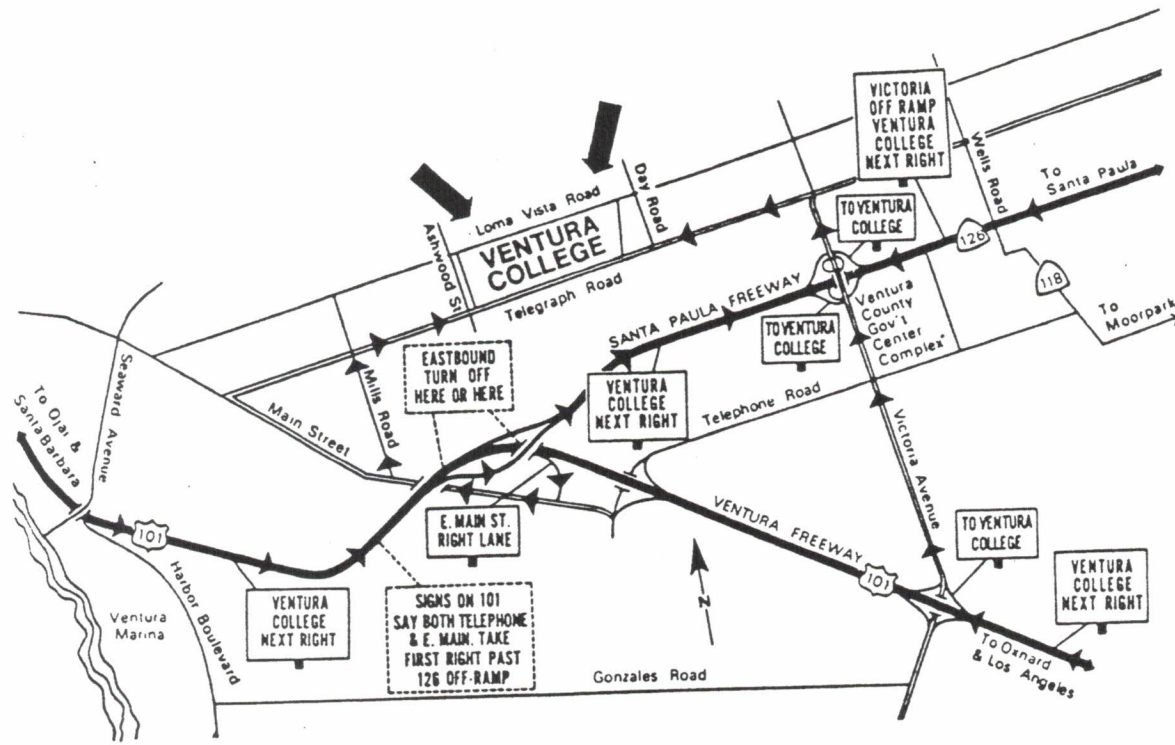

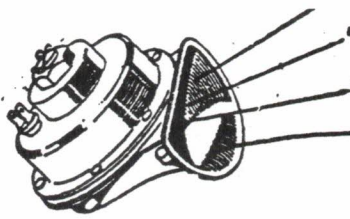
