PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

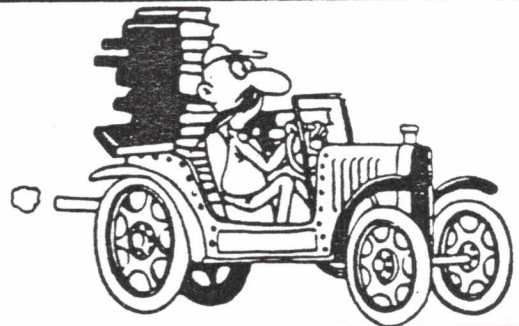
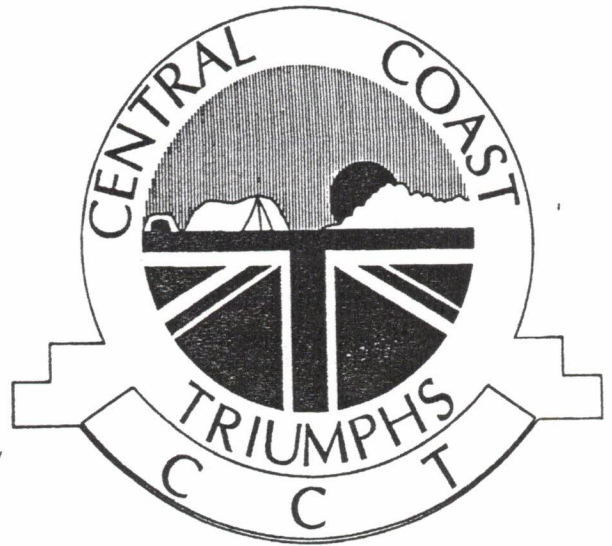

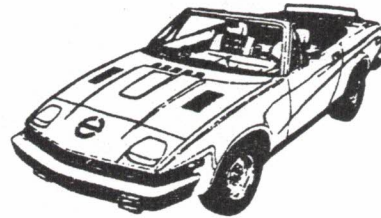






**JUNE 13 SWAP MEET**

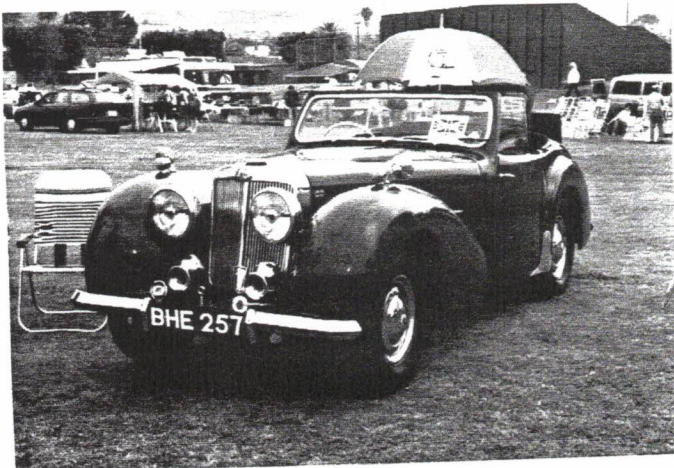

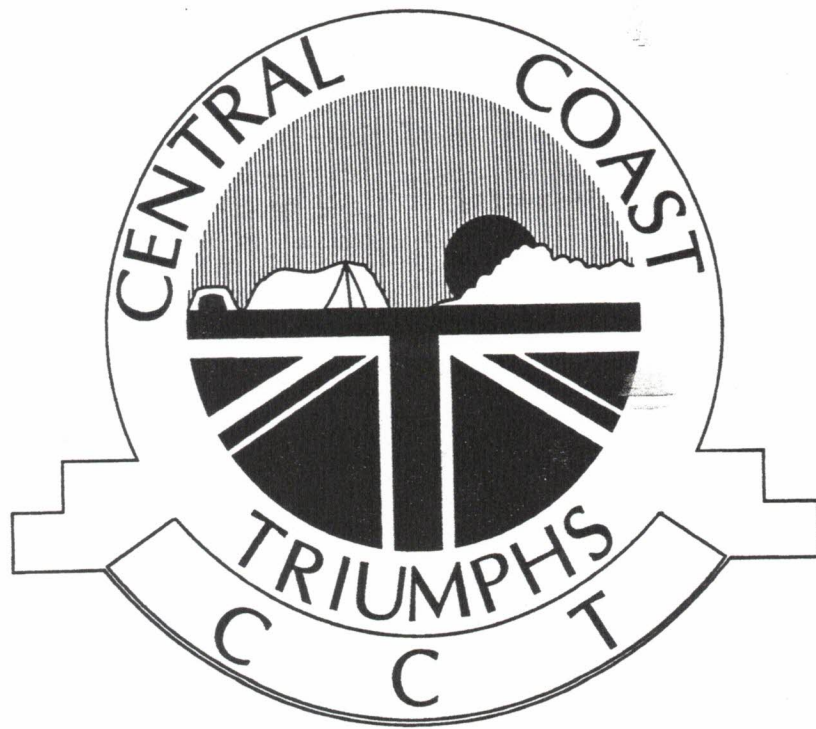
