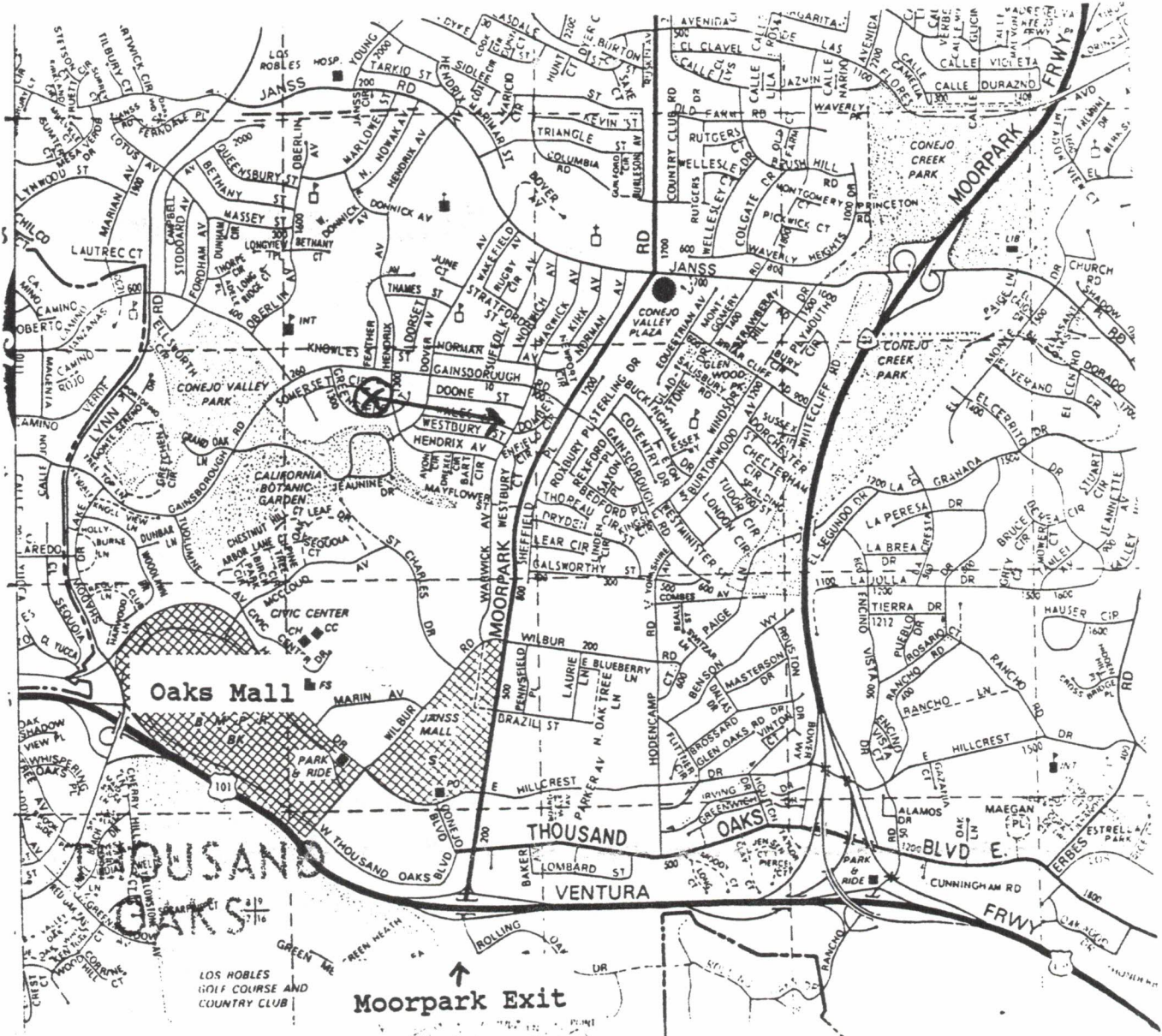

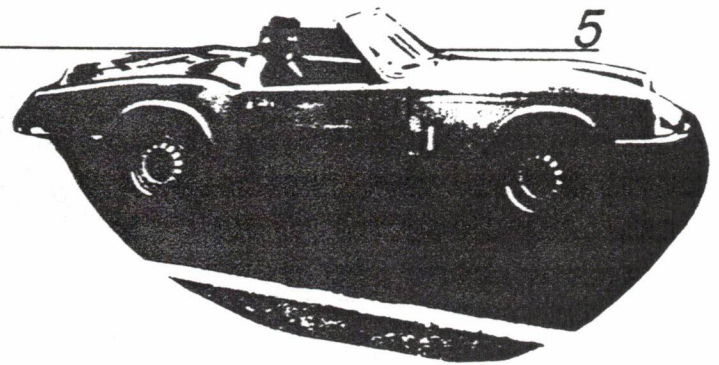


To Brunch and

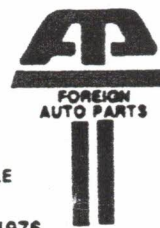

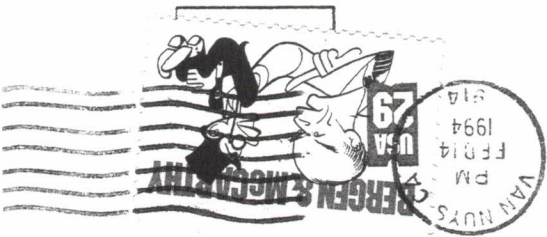
