

Notes from the Pres.....


Happy New Year to all !!!!





Jim and Diane Mills, who joined CCTABCC in May 1995, are proud owners of a 1964 TR4 (CT37815L). The car was first purchased from George Willis Motors (location?) on 8 July 1965. Jim bought it in 1969 while he was in the Navy stationed at San Diego. He bought it at the "Grand Prix Pit Stop" used car lot on El Cajon Blvd., and consummated the deal at midnight over a six pack. He paid the grand sum of \$1,400. The car appeared to have been repaired once for body damage but was otherwise in good shape with very little rust. 
Dear Triumph Club:


I am interested in joining your club. I have a 1962 Triumph TR-4 which I am restoring. I have rebuilt the engine and transmission and put them back in the car. After starting the car I found that I could not fully disengage the clutch even though the clutch cylinder was adjusted for maximum travel. Both the master and slave cylinders are new and have been bleed well.

Someone told me that this is typical and that I should just run it with the clutch partially engaged until enough clutch pad material wears off to allow normal disengagement. This doesn't sound too wise to me.

Does anyone in the club know of this problem and what the best solution for me might be.
