On 2 December 1996, Senator Quentin Kopp who is the chairman of the Senate Transportation Committee introduced Senate Bill 42. This bill would exempt all automobiles 25 years and newer from smog testing. The Bill is not law yet and is expected to come up for a vote within a few weeks.

Under the current "Smog II" law, all vehicles newer than 1965 must pass the new smog tests. "Smog II" was implemented in 1995 and is much more stringent than the previous smog tests. Many of our members cars have been categorized as "gross polluters" by the DMV under the new requirements. Completely restored 4 & 6 cylinder roadsters are now required to pass requirements in excess of what was required when it was new from the factory. The California EPA intention is to take all vehicles since 1965 off the road (no matter what it's condition or collectability is). If this continues, it is our opinion that "1965" will eventually no longer be a sacred year and will be subject to the new smog laws as well.

Now is your window of opportunity. We urge you to contact your legislatures, both Senator and Assembly persons as well as Governor Pete Wilson by phone, letter, postcard and/or E\_mail, and strongly urge them to approve Senate Bill No. 42. You can find your Representatives name, address and phone number in the white pages of your local phone book in the front section under "State Government Offices, Assembly and Senate".
