Transmission Lubricants by Ken Gilanders



About 10 years ago we began a series of long term tests on various products and materials. Some of these long term tests have been reported on and some were discontinued when better solutions were found, and others continue.

In about 1985 we found that the recommended lubricants for the TR gearbox were very different from the requirements for the electric overdrive. In fact they were mutually exclusive. The TR workshop manual stated that gear oil 90w was required, as the film strength of a purpose-formulated gear oil was the only thing that would protect the inner bearing surface of the cluster gear & the outer bearing surface of the cluster shaft from being destroyed by the unit loading on the needle bearings at the first gear end. As an aside you may have wondered why the parts always fail at the rear of the gearbox. This is because the lowest of the forward gears is first and it can generate the most leverage to try to force the gear set apart since it has the most mechanical advantage.

Now in the case of the overdrive, the problem was that the prominent active ingredient in gear oil will soften and sometimes dissolve the friction material on the clutches.

Well, this was indead a Solomon-sized dilemma. As it happened, about this time the major motor oil refiners began to produce a multiple viscosity racing motor oil that was low on detergent but very heavy on film strength additives and anti-foam additives. When we looked at the characteristics, without reference to what it was originally intended for, we felt we had the perfect solution.



That was about 10 years ago and up to this point we have had no failures of any kind. The problem would have been immediately appearent as we had used my car for the test. It now shifts both up and down without delay and with the slightly softer engagement that I had originaly built in. The operating pressure is the same at the same speeds and there was no evidence of clutch material in the overdrive screen. There was no unusual dirt inside the unit, at least as far as I could see with not having dissassembled it. I had just drained the units checked the oil for debris, checked the O/D screen, looked about inside as best I could and changed to fresh Valvoline Racing 20/50. I am sure that any of the major refiners probably have a similar product but I wanted to extend the test to 20 years.




