The car was originally purchased by a family in Riverside in 1974. The car was then sold in 1995.

The next owners resided in Ojai, they owned the car until 2002. They sold the car to a gentleman who was in the United States Navy named Bill Landon who I believe lived in Camarillo or Oxnard. While Bill was in the Navy he was stationed in Louisiana, Texas and then off to Sicily.

Bill had the car shipped to all three locations. The car actually participated in some car shows while in Italy! I've attached a couple of photos that I believe were taken while in Italy. Bill and the car eventually ended up back in Camarillo and then sold the car to Steve Doll in 2015.

I purchased the car from Steve in December of 2016. I've been working on some of the wiring and have replaced the master cylinder for the brakes and the hydraulic cylinders for the clutch. I've also replaced the radiator, water pump and hoses. The car is in pretty good shape and runs well!

Speaker at the June meeting - "GOING TOPLESS THIS SUMMER"



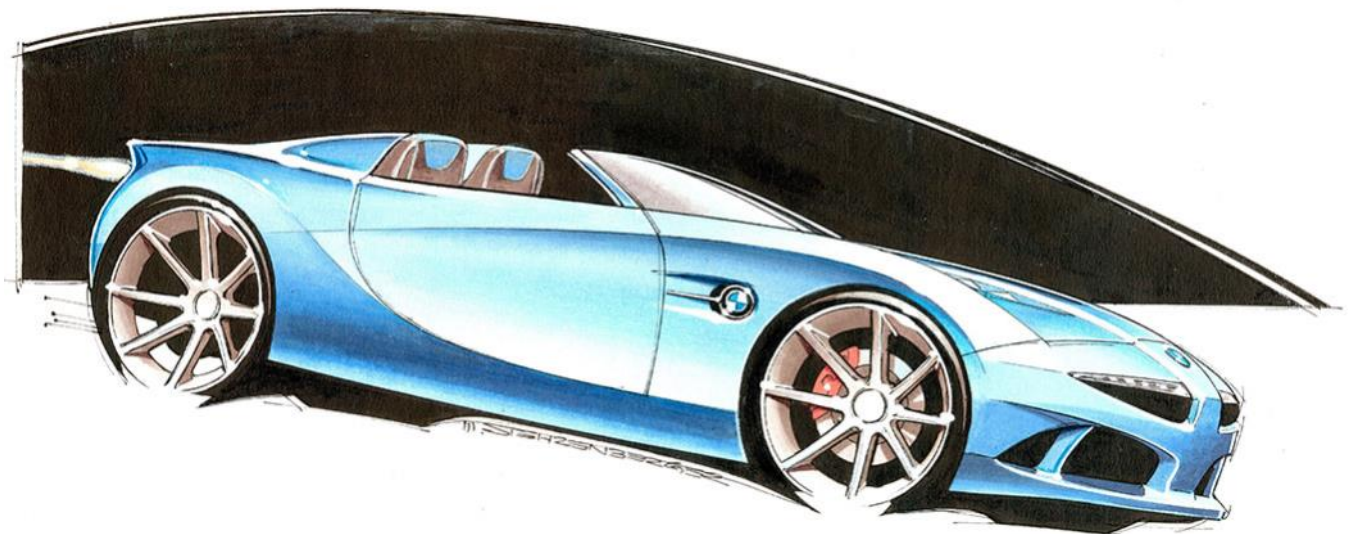
The evolution of the convertible and the top 10 reasons why we should ABSOLUTELY have one.
