## Speaker at the June meeting "GOING TOPLESS THIS SUMMER"



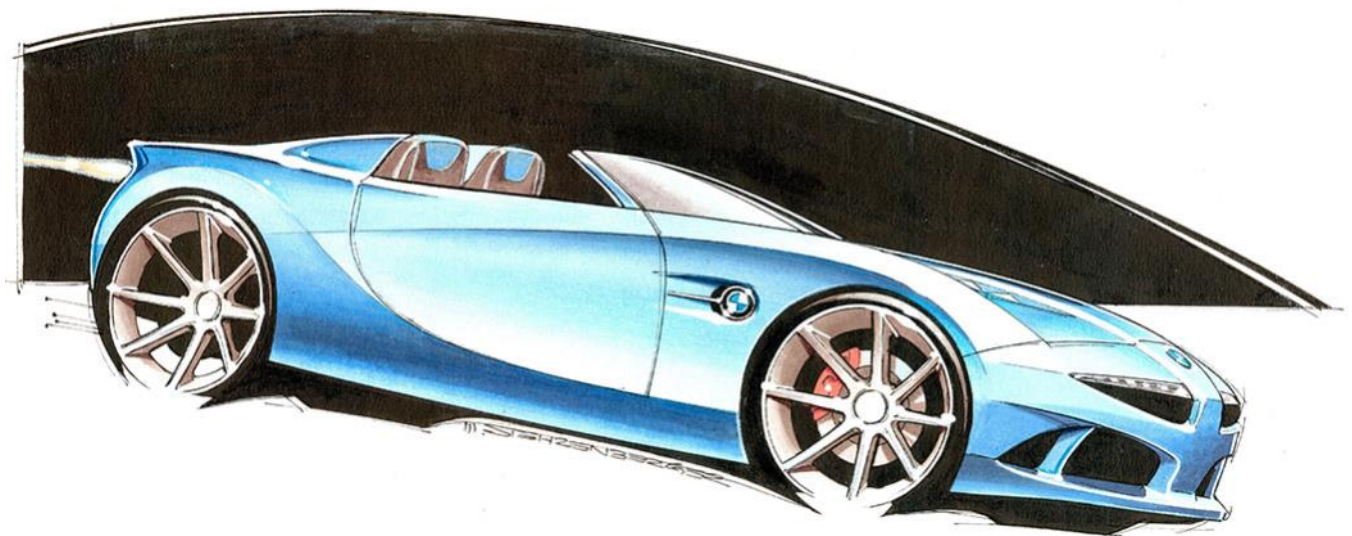

## ReCap of the CCBCC run to the Santa Susana Depot in Simi Valley



The information below is from the website of the Depot:

Built in 1903 by the Southern Pacific Railroad, the Santa Susana Depot served passengers and farmers in the Simi Valley for more than 60 years. With a classic passenger waiting room featuring a pot-belly stove, the depot was also headquarters for local freight shipments. It was also the home of the station agent. Today the Depot is the home of the Rancho Simi Foundation and the Santa Susana Pacific Model Railroad Club where Amtrak, Metrolink and Union Pacific trains pass by every day.

The depot was also the home of the station agent. Some of the agents duties were selling passenger tickets, routing freight, and passing orders to the train crews. Telegraphed messages to operators or agents at each station along the line controlled the train movement.

The depot was also a meeting place for people picking up mail or sending telegrams and for those on their way in or out of the valley.

The depot was moved to its current spot in the Santa Susana Park near the existing Union Pacific mainline railroad tracks on Katherine Road. Restoration and landscaping of the facility began in 1983 and was completed in 1996.

Not only did the Rancho Simi Foundation restore the depot but also created a museum that represents what it would have looked like back in 1938. The Pacific Model Train Club has created a HO layout that represents the area in the 1950's.

In the pre-run phase, Jim Heaton was in touch with the Director of Operations at Santa Paula Airport wherein she confirmed that, despite the rain prediction, the "First Sunday Open House" will occur. The only limitation will be that there will be fewer take-offs and landings. 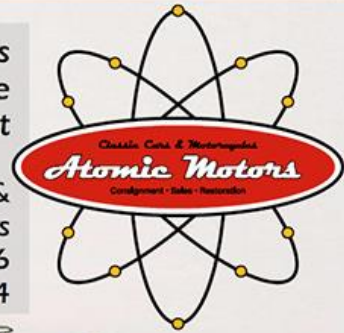
