Changed the dash wood to Burlwood, deleted the radio and added an Oil pressure and Volt gauge. I also added a lot of heat insulation under the carpet. And a new headliner.

## Continued from Cover Story



On the exterior of the car, the lower 8" of body work all the way around the car needed to be replaced, as well as above the windshield. From rust damage, the side marker lights and antenna were removed and the holes filled. The rear view mirrors were moved from the doors to the bonnet.

The steering rack was replaced with a quicker rack from a Spitfire, the front sway bar was upgraded to a larger bar. The front brakes are now slotted, the shocks are Gazz adjustable with lower springs. The rear suspension up changed to a CV joint setup. The frame was powder coated in the same color as the body work. A J type over drive was added.

The engine was built to Triumphtune stage 3 spec. With the exception of triple Strongberg Carbs instead of Webers. Richard Good massaged the Head, with bigger intake and exhaust Valves. Plus Valve springs and pushrods. BHP was 88 and is now near a BHP 160.

A/P bolts were used, and a Good GP3 cam, plus the compression was changed from 8:25 to 9:25, The rotating mass was balanced, The car also has a header, Oil cooler, Aluminum Radiator and a programable 123 distributor, plus a sport exhaust.

The body work was done at Body and Paint by Jeff, in Oxnard. And the overall project plus reassembly was done Full Scale Hot Rod in Ventura.

Now I have the GT6 that Triumph should have built.
