PRESIDENTS MESSAGE



The elections are coming up in December, where we elect the board members. Normally I would not be talking about the elections this early, but this year is a different situation. The club cannot function unless we fill these two positions. I cannot emphasize this enough.

The club recorder position is a one-year term and entails taking minutes at the club meetings and events. There is a form to fill out for this and it really does not take up much time. This position has voting rights and you must attend the general and board meetings. The board meetings are done remotely over Skype once a month. In case you are wondering, we need to record our meeting minutes to conform to the club by laws. Our by-laws allow us to be a nonprofit club registered with the state and federal government.

The President position is two-year term and entails making sure the club runs smoothly. This includes running the monthly board and general meetings, working with the board, and ensuring the club adheres to the by-laws.

I have been the President of the club for the last 5-1/2 years and have really enjoyed doing this job. When Jim Hill approached me about running for President, I was very apprehensive about it. I thought about it for weeks and finally decided that someone needed to do it, or the club may not exist. I am very glad I made the decision to run. I have gotten to work with some fantastic people and made lots of friends during this time. It has been very enjoyable time for me being club President.

If you are thinking about either of these positions, please keep in mind that you will not be alone and you will have help. Our current recorder Martin Keller will be available for questions and the other board members will help as well. For the President position I will remain as the President's advisor and will be available for any questions or guidance.

We are also creating a new position in the club for an Assistant Treasurer. Chris Vujea is our Treasurer now. Next year she will be doing a lot of traveling. This means she will not be able to do some of the local duties. We are looking for someone to volunteer to pick up the mail a couple times a week in Ventura, make bank deposits when we get checks, and attend the board meetings remotely. In Chris's absence this position will get a vote in the board meetings. For this position you do not need any bookkeeping knowledge.

To keep the club going we will need some members to volunteer for these positions. Please contact me if you have any questions or are interested in any of the positions.



Car Show at the Camarillo Airshow

It was truly a Premiere Air Show! Complete with pyrotechnics!

On Sunday, August 21, 2022, more than a dozen Central Coast British Car Club members met at the Willis and Eubanks intersection. They had gathered to attend the car show at Camarillo Airport's 41st Annual Wings Over Camarillo Air Show, Car Show and Exhibits.

The outside temperature was cold, humid and cloudy. When the proper time arrived, 14 cars representing CCBCC drove onto the airfield's car show area. We were on row three of what would become six rows of cars present.

We were all busy getting our cars ready for the show. Some set up displays, others placed their sitting chairs facing the runway and still others polished and cleaned their cars. As the morning progressed, the temperature warmed and the overcast sky became clearer and clearer.

After the car set-ups were completed, a few members toured the car show field looking at the other interesting automobiles. Some of the vehicles were very impressive. Zelda stayed at her MGB and talked to almost everyone who walked past the car. She allowed children and young adults to sit in the driver's seat and hopefully become future British car drivers. The children enjoyed pretending to drive her car. The parents took photographs of their child, thoroughly happy. As the day progressed on, a beautiful red Ferrari parked next to our red MGB.

The air show officially opened up with the singing of the Stars Spangled Banner, and military cadet paratroopers jumping out of their plane. One trooper had an American Flag attached to his foot. As part of this opening act, the paratroopers performed various acrobatic stunts and then landed in a precise spot on the field. Next, the single wing and Bi-plane aircraft performed acrobatics. One of the acts, Skywriting, was about writing a huge heart in the sky.

As the morning became afternoon, it was time for the Parade of Cars on the runway. Four vehicles from our club (MGB 1980, MGB 1979, a MGB and a Triumph TR 250), had the honor of driving in the parade. The parade of cars were split into two lines so British cars were mentioned twice during the parade.

Once the parade was over, the most of the cars left the show field. The air show continued on with more aerodynamic acts with turbo jets which consisted of civilian pilots and then the military pilots flew their crafts. Those stunts were body shaking and ear shatteringly loud. When the pyrotechnics went off, you could feel the heat and impact of the blast from across the runway.

When it was all said and done, the children were exhausted and the adults were hot and sweaty. Everybody wanted to go home. But, we all walked back to our cars with smiles on our faces. It was a great show.




